#### Foreword

#### Helina Chan

A dynamic duo, classy pair and loving couple, Delia and Milenko Prvački are familiar faces in Singapore's art scene. Both veteran practitioners, with Delia working mainly with ceramics and Milenko in paintings, their works are bound to challenge the convention and evoke questions about an enigmatic pictorial world, weaved with a rebellious interpretation of a visual vocabulary. The Topography of Hybrid Imagery presents a series of creations tracing their common artistic background and intends to create a dialogue on contemporary art.

The two first locked eyes in the Bucharest Institute in Fine Arts, where Delia studied Applied Arts while Milenko read Fine Arts (Painting) under the mentorship of renowned Romanian painter, Corneliu Baba. Drawn together by their like-mindedness, the pair married after graduation and have since been the muse to each other. In Delia's own words, as a sign of destiny, Milenko accepted a job offer overseas in 1991, a decision that led them to start a new chapter of their lives in sunny Singapore. The intended short relief from the tragedies in then Yugoslavia turned into a permanent stay. Eventually, the husband and wife became Singapore citizens in 2002, making this little red dot their home. Today, Milenko is one of Singapore's most prominent art educators, having joined LASALLE College of the Arts since 1994 and conferred the prestigious Cultural Medallion Award in 2012, while Delia won numerous awards across the globe and is widely recognised for her multi-medium commissioned public projects.

Along the trajectory to perfect their crafts, Delia and Milenko continue to stay beyond the limits of modern art forms. To put it briefly, the shifts in

political and social climates led to first, a recurring motif of displacement and recollections in their works, then fragmentations of memory and progressively, a brilliant reinvention of approaches and expressions.

Delia's works, mostly realised in complex ceramics techniques, stem from her connection with the natural phenomena and her persistent uneasiness with the perpetual and radical transformation of space in the urban city. Feeling the need to respond to such modern dilemmas, her experimental works are often new biostructures derived from a variety of methods and fantastic archaeological discoveries. The blending and assemblage of ideals and matters thus give rise to a stimulating visual and fine art language of her own.

Milenko's take on the "dictionary" approach resonates with Delia's theme and is infused with a strong injection of sophisticated experimentation of materials. His visual imageries reverberate themes of the current world and demonstrate an extraordinary command of colours and light. The rawness and few drops of spontaneity in his paintings presented poetically are deeply evocative of the complexity of one's existence and the endless possibilities in the land of living.

I am constantly in awe of the couple's metamorphose of visual lexicons and the impressive, multi-layered, visual lingo that they have established over the years. I am delighted to show their works at iPreciation and I hope that you will enjoy viewing them as much as I do.

# Delia Prvacki

(b. 1950, Baia Mare, Romania)

Delia Prvacki graduated from the Bucharest Institute of Fine Arts in 1975 with a Master in Applied Arts. Subsequently, she moved to former Yugoslavia to practice art, and received numerous awards including the Special Award and Critic's Award (1981) at the Yugoslav Triennial of Ceramics, and the Annual Art Award (1982) by the Serbian Association of Applied Artists.

In 1991, Delia relocated to Singapore with Milenko Prvacki and her family. She is widely recognised for her major public projects which have been a focal point in many urban areas and institutions such as Shangri-La Hotel, Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore Power Building, NUS (Alice Lee Plaza) and Marina South Pier MRT Station.

Delia's works are in the permanent collections of Museum of Modern Art, Belgrade, Yugoslavia, Museum of Ceramics, Porvoo-Borgaa, Finland, Singapore Art Museum, Singapore, NUS Museum, Singapore, among others.

# Milenko Prvacki

(b. 1951, Vojvodina, Former Yugoslavia)

Milenko Prvacki graduated with a Masters in Fine Arts (Painting) from the Bucharest Institute of Fine Arts. Before moving to Singapore in 1991, he had exhibited extensively throughout Europe, winning many awards, including the Special Jury Award (1986), Academie Internationale De Lutece, France and the 2nd International Drawing Triennial, Museum of Contemporary Drawing Award and Faber-Castell Award (1982), Nurnberg, Germany. Having joined Singapore's LASALLE College of the Arts since 1994, served as a Dean and now as a Senior Fellow, Milenko is regarded as one of Singapore's foremost art educator. For his contributions to Singapore's visual art scene, Milenko was conferred the prestigious Cultural Medallion in 2012 by the National Arts Council.

Milenko's works are in the permanent collections of the Gallery of New South Wales, Sydney Australia, Museum of Contemporary Art, Belgrade, Serbia, Singapore Art Museum, Singapore and Museum of Contemporary Drawing, Nurnberg, Germany, among others.
